1. Name of each part

Home position (Degree of transposition 0)

"The position where the chords transposition before and after transposition is the same" is a home position.

If the tap of the **all Clear** button is carried out, it will return to a home position. (All the window closed)

It returns to a manual mode simultaneously. (State which can be inputted by chords)

It is in the state of the upper photograph.

2. Prepare Score.

There is a chords which is not easy in this score.

When it performs, it is too highpitch, or sound is too lowpitch to sing.

The example of a score is shown below.

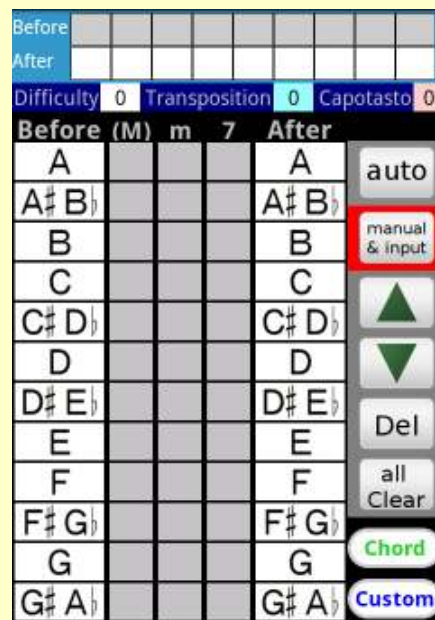

3. Home position (Degree of transposition 0)

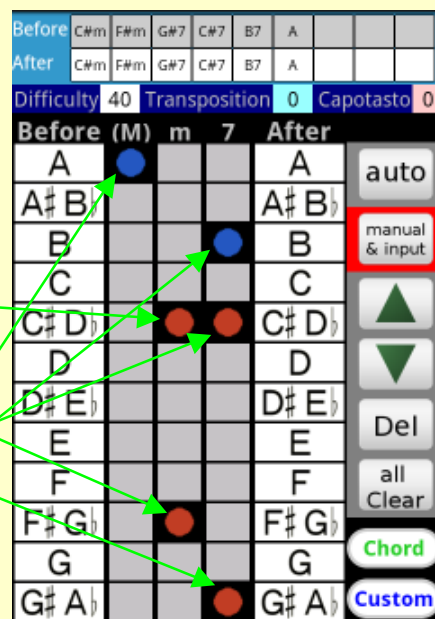
If the tap of the **all Clear** button is carried out, it will return to a home position. (Refer to photograph 1.)

4. Tap the corresponding windows

- ① C#m Tap "m" Column, "C#" Line window.
- ② F#m Tap "m" Column, "F#" Line window.
- ③ Ab7 Tap "7" Column, "Ab" Line window.
- ④ C#7 Tap "7" Column, "C#" Line window.
- ⑤ B7 Tap "7" Column, "B" Line window.
- ⑥ A Tap "(M)" Column, "A" Line window.



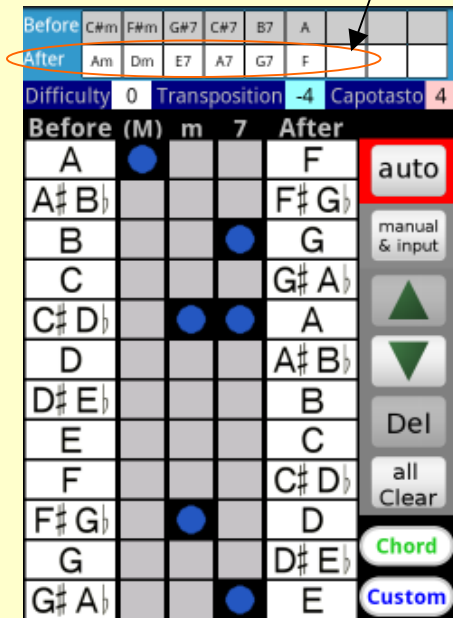

5. Looking for easy chords

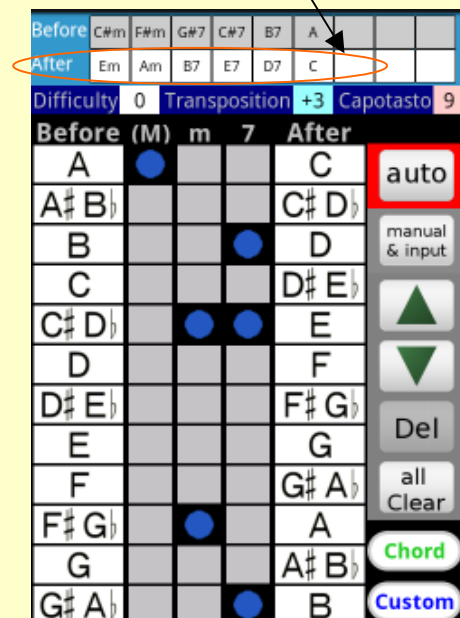
5. 1 Looking for easy chords by **auto** button

On states 4(Refer to photograph 2) ,Tap the **auto**
 The chords which is the easiest to play is displayed. (Refer to photograph 3.)
 (In the case of the same difficulty, a capo position is small)

Tap the ▼ . The chords which is the next easy to play is displayed. (Refer to photograph 4.)

5. 2 Looking for easy chords by **manual & input** button

- ① In the state of 4, please look at the window. (Refer to photograph 2.)
There are four red circles.This shows that there are four difficult chords. Capo position : 0
- ② In the state of 4 ,Tap  . Please look at the windows.
There are three red circles.This shows that there are three difficult chords. Capo position : 1
- ③ Tap the  once again. Please look at the windows.
There are one red circle.This shows that there are one difficult chord. Capo position : 2
- ④ Tap the  once again. Please look at the windows.
There are four red circles.This shows that there are four difficult chords. Capo position : 3
- ⑤ Tap the  once again. Please look at the windows.



All the circles are blue.This shows that there are all easy chord. Capo position : 4

(Refer to photograph 3)

- ⑥ Tap the  once again. Please look at the windows.
There are five red circles.This shows that there are five difficult chords. Capo position : 5
- ⑦ Tap the  once again. Please look at the windows.
There are three red circles.This shows that there are three difficult chords. Capo position : 6
- ⑧ Tap the  once again. Please look at the windows.
There are three red circles.This shows that there are three difficult chords. Capo position : 7
- ⑨ Tap the  once again. Please look at the windows.
There are three red circles.This shows that there are three difficult chords. Capo position : 8
- ⑩ Tap the  once again. Please look at the windows.

All the circles are blue.This shows that there are all easy chord. Capo position : 9

(Refer to photograph 4)

- ⑪ Tap the  once again. Please look at the windows.
There are six red circles.This shows that there are six difficult chords. Capo position : 10
- ⑫ Tap the  once again. Please look at the windows.
There are two red circles.This shows that there are two difficult chords. Capo position : 11

Notes:

Even if it uses which position, when there is a red circle,
it is easy to play all and cannot change them.

There is only choosing the fewest conversion of red and practicing the surviving red's code.

6. The procedure of changing a chords

6. 1 When performing in the same pitch as conversion before using a capo

- ① In the state of 5, let's choose the photograph 3.
- ② Let's change a Before chords into a After chords.

- ③ Let's rewrite a score.

After-change 1

For an easy play

<p>G7 now still more</p>	<p>F change to easy chords</p>

- ④ The capo is placed on the 4th fret.
- ⑤ Let's play the rewritten score.

6. 2 When you want to change a pitch

- ① When play without capo (After-change 1), it is in this case, becomes lower 4 pitch.
- ② When play without capo (After-change 2), it is in this case, becomes higher 3 pitch. (Refer to photograph 4)

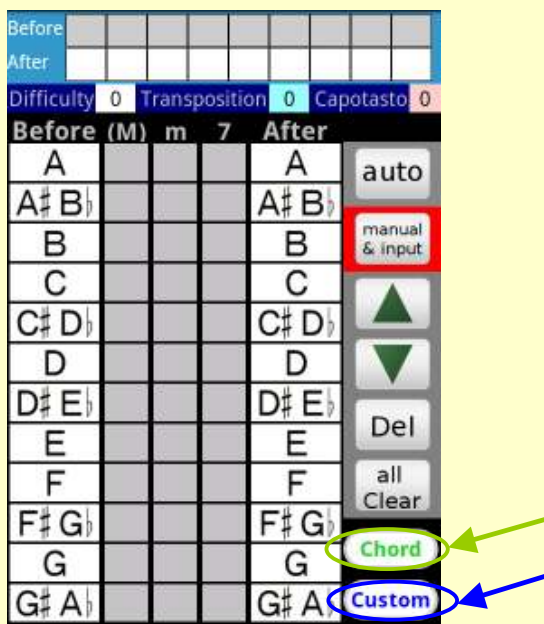

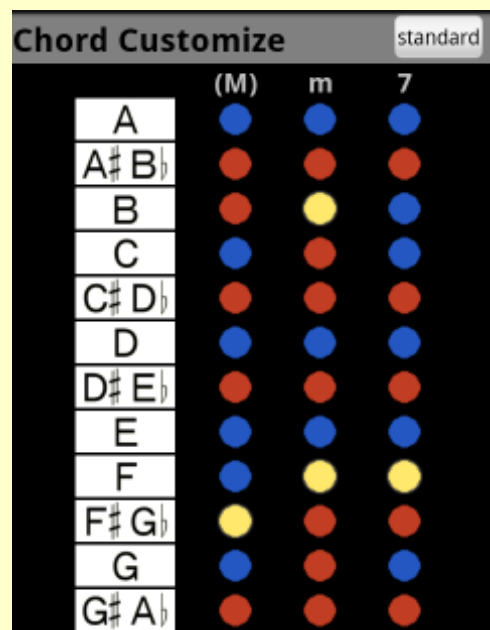
7. How to customize the difficulty of chords according to you

- ① Tap **Custom** button (Refer to photograph 5) or choose customize from menus.
- ② It changes sequentially if the tap is done. (Refer to photograph 6)
 (● → ● → ● → ● ...)
 Example When you can surely perform Bm
 Tap Minor chords Column, Bchords Line ● → ●
- ③ Tap X button.

(When you want to return to the standard, tap standard)



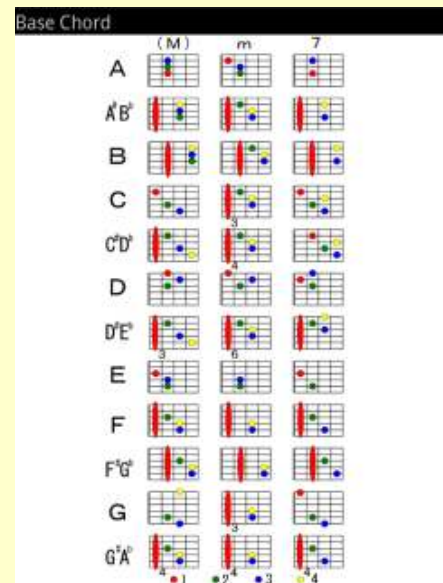

8. Basic chords

- ① Tap **Chord** button. (Refer to photograph 5.)
or The tap does the "Basic chords" button of the menu.
- ② The basic chords is displayed. (Refer to photograph 7.)
